Scouting is a movement for the development of youth. Scouting uses the patrol method and outdoor activities, along with troop meetings, camps, games, advancements, badges, to help youth develop into a valuable, patriotic, honorable, loyal, cheerful, and a helpful person.

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- Each Scout must be registered with BSA. The Scouting experience is divided into programs according to age:



Cub Scouting
Grades K-5
(5-10 years old)



Scouts BSA
Grades 6-12
(11-17 years old)

- Each Scout must have an account set up with Scoutlander, and required to register for troop activities on Scoutlander. (www.scoutlander.com)

PARENT PARTICIPATION

The assistance of parents is key to the success of any scout troop. The more a parent is involved, the more the Scout is likely to stay involved and advance in rank.

Parents support the troop by:

- Attending Parent Committee meetings
- Driving and/or participating in outings
- Helping with fund raising activities
- Assisting in planning for activities
- Serving as an Assistant Scoutmaster
- Serving on the Parent Committee
- Serving on Boards of Review to assist in rank advancement

Parents can assist their Scout by:

- Attend all troop and committee meetings.
- Regularly check the Troop's emailing list for updates.
- Reading their Scout's handbook and understand the purpose and methods of Scouting.
- Be aware of the troop program and annual calendar. All troop activities are discussed at the meetings and posted on the Scoutlander calendar.
- Actively follow their Scout's progress (or lack thereof) and offer encouragement and a gentle "push" if needed.
- Show support to your Scout and the Troop by attending every Court of Honor.

MEETING, ACTIVITIES AND PARTICIPATION

1. Troop meetings are held every Saturday at Kearny Mesa Recreation Center at 1:30 PM – 4:00 PM or at a time and place to be determined by the Troop Committee and Scoutmaster to accommodate special circumstances.

2. All Scouts registered with the Pack/Troop/Crew are expected to regularly attend and participate in troop meetings, patrol meetings, campouts, community service events and other Troop/Patrol activities.

3. Comply with their elected youth leader's direction. Any abuse of authority should promptly be brought to the attention of the Scoutmaster.

4. Participate in the running of the Troop and Patrol. Scouts with a rank of First Class and above are expected to serve in youth positions periodically. Positions of Responsibility are not just to be held when needed for rank advancement.

5. Help teach skills to other scouts.

6. Each Scout will have a Scout Handbook, notebook and pen/pencil in possession at all Troop meetings and activities unless instructed otherwise.

7. Scouts who make commitments to participate in Troop activities must faithfully keep all such commitments. Failure to keep commitments without a valid excuse shows poor Scout Spirit and may result in the Scout not being able to go on camping trips, advance in rank or maintain a leadership position.

UNIFORMS

1. All Scouts are required to wear the official "Class A" uniform at all Pack/Troop/Crew meetings and activities. The Scoutmaster may designate the wearing of other clothes for Troop activities when it is deemed to be appropriate.

2. The "Class A" uniform has the scout shirt, official scout pants or shorts, hat, troop neckerchief and slide, scout belt, and sneakers.

3. The "Class A" uniform shall be worn for all Advancement Conferences, Boards of Review, and Courts of Honor.

4. The Scout shall treat the uniform with respect and wear it proudly.

5. The "Class B" uniform consists of the official Troop turquoise t-shirt.

6. Scouts should be prepared to stand a uniform inspection at any Troop meeting or activity without prior notice.

7. The Scout's appearance needs to be appropriate when attending meetings or Scouting events.

8. A notebook, Scout Handbook, pen and/or pencil are required at every meeting.
